MINUTE OF THE ENVIRONMENT COURT

(12 April 2021)

Introduction

- [1] On 2 November 2020 counsel for Te Korowai o Ngāruahine Trust (Ngāruahine) filed a notice of motion seeking to withdraw its interests in the appeal in full. Counsel advised that the parties do not oppose the withdrawal¹.
- [2] Te Kaahui o Rauru (**Ngaa Rauru**) is a section 274 party to the appeal. On 2 November 2020, it applied to "substitute itself as the appellant" in place of Ngāruahine (**Application**).
- [3] In the Minute of 2 December 2020, the Court placed Ngāruahine's proposed withdrawal and Ngaa Rauru's Application on hold pending the undertaking of

further work by Ngaa Rauru. As such, the Ngāruahine appeal is technically still live and Ngaa Rauru is not yet an appellant.

Withdrawal of Ngaa Rauru

- [4] In a memorandum dated 6 April 2021, counsel for Ngaa Rauru sought to withdraw Ngaa Rauru's s 274 interest in the Ngāruahine appeal, as well as its Application.
- [5] Ngaa Rauru canvassed the parties and received no objection to the proposed withdrawal, including as to costs². The Court requested that the remaining parties advise the Court of their position, to which the remaining parties except for Federated Farmers of New Zealand, advised of having no issues.

Directions

- [6] Ngaa Rauru's s 274 interest in the Ngāruahine appeal, as well as its Application, are noted as withdrawn.
- [7] Ngāruahine's appeal is also noted as withdrawn, with no issues as to costs. The file will now be closed.
- [8] Given that Mr Knuckey and Ngāruahine have withdrawn their appeals, there are no remaining appeals interested in Topic 5 (Tangata Whenua).
