If an emergency arises and we are unable to get home, we will meet at:

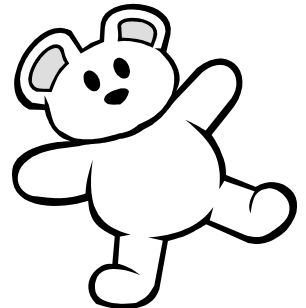

**LOCK** our house and garage

**CHECK** our neighbourhood support group

# DON'T GO SIGHTSEEING



### FLOODS

Follow instructions given on your local radio station. If you live in a flood path, be ready to evacuate. Don't go into flood waters.



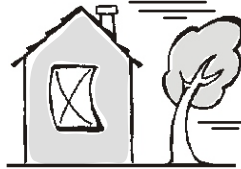
### EARTHQUAKE

Take cover in a doorway or under a table. Do not run outside - you may be hit by falling objects.



### VOLCANIC

Follow instructions given on your local radio station. Stay indoors as much as possible. Conserve food and water. Keep your pets indoors.



### STORMS

Secure outdoor furniture and objects. Bring bins and outdoor furniture inside. Stay indoors.
