

Clarification of some key transport related services in Taranaki

ACCESS discounted bus fares

These are administered by the Taranaki Disabilities Information Centre Trust (TDICT) on behalf of the Taranaki Regional Council. ACCESS is a **reduced bus fare** available for people with permanent or temporary disabilities, enabling them to travel on CityLink bus services within New Plymouth, Bell Block, Oakura and Waitara, for a discounted amount. Using the service requires an eligibility card which is obtained from TDICT, and presented to the driver when asking for an ACCESS discounted fare.

Mobility Parking Permits

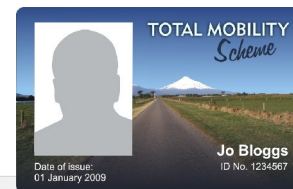
The Mobility Parking Permit Scheme is owned and administered by CCS Disability Action. Those people that apply and qualify for a mobility permit receive an orange permit card stamped with a membership number and expiry date (fees apply). This orange permit enables the permit holder to **park conveniently close to their destination** in accessible reserved parking spaces as long as their permit is clearly displayed on the inside of the vehicle windscreen or on the dashboard.

Total Mobility

The Total Mobility Scheme is administered by the Taranaki Regional Council within this region, and usually by regional councils throughout the country. It is a **reduced taxi fare scheme** through an ID Card and voucher system, which saves eligible disabled users up to half the cost of a normal fare. TRC contracts Marion Wellington as the Co-ordinator for Taranaki.

The SuperGold Card is a **free discount and concession card** available to all New Zealanders who are aged 65 years or over, and those under 65 years receiving New Zealand Superannuation or the Veteran's Pension. One of the benefits is free off-peak travel on public transport (between 9am and 3pm weekdays, and all Saturday services).
