- 6.2 It was noted that Venture Taranaki need to get champions out in the community, identify where their passions are, identify potential projects where we can engage the community and build relationships in science. She noted that TRC is their main source of scientists and having TRC scientists involved in these projects is extremely valuable.
- 6.3 Mr S Ruru, Chief Executive noted that the big focus of the Regional Recovery funding with NPDC was the current housing project, and gave indication he would seek further updates from NPDC and report back on the TRC component to a future meeting.
