Purpose

The purpose of this memorandum is to introduce the submissions on the Consultation Document for the 2019/2020 Annual Plan, hear those submitters who wish to speak to their written submission and to recommend any changes to the Plan.

Recommendations

That the Taranaki Regional Council:

- 1. <u>receives</u> and <u>acknowledges</u> with thanks the submissions forwarded in response to the Consultation Document on the 2019/2020 Annual Plan and supporting documentation
- 2. <u>advises</u> the Chief Executive of any changes to the 2019/2020 Annual Plan as a result of submissions
- 3. <u>notes</u> the amended 2019/2020 Annual Plan and estimates will be considered and adopted at the Council's Ordinary Meeting on 21 May 2019.

Background

Pursuant to the *Local Government Act* 2002, the Council has prepared a Consultation Document and supporting documentation to enable the preparation and adoption of its 2019/2020 *Annual Plan*. The Consultation Document is part of the public consultation process pursuant to section 83 of the *Local Government Act* 2002.

Discussion

The Consultation Document and supporting documentation for the 2019/2020 Annual Plan were adopted on 26 February 2019 and publicly notified as being available for submissions on 16 March 2019. The submissions closed on 23 April 2019.

A total of 526 submissions were received. Attached to this memorandum is a schedule of those submitters who wish to present their submission.

Attached to this memorandum is a summary of the submissions. The Officer's Report provides additional information and commentary to assist Councillors in considering and hearing submissions received on the 2019/2020 Annual Plan and the associated consultation document. A copy of each of the submissions is attached.

The process at this meeting is to hear all those submitters who wish to present their submission, to consider and make recommendations on all of the submissions.

As a result of these recommendations, the 2019/2020 Annual Plan will be updated and presented for adoption at the Council's Ordinary Meeting on 21 May 2019. It is proposed to set the rates for 2019/2020 2 July 2019 Ordinary Meeting.

Decision-making considerations

Part 6 (Planning, decision-making and accountability) of the *Local Government Act* 2002 has been considered and documented in the preparation of this agenda item. The recommendations made in this item comply with the decision-making obligations of the *Act*.

Financial considerations—LTP/Annual Plan

This memorandum and the associated recommendations are consistent with the Council's adopted Long-Term Plan and estimates. Any financial information included in this memorandum has been prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting practice.

Policy considerations

This memorandum and the associated recommendations are consistent with the policy documents and positions adopted by this Council under various legislative frameworks including, but not restricted to, the *Local Government Act* 2002, the *Resource Management Act* 1991 and the *Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act* 1987.

Iwi considerations

This memorandum and the associated recommendations are consistent with the Council's policy for the development of Māori capacity to contribute to decision-making processes (schedule 10 of the *Local Government Act* 2002) as outlined in the adopted long-term plan and/or annual plan. Similarly, iwi involvement in adopted work programmes has been recognised in the preparation of this memorandum.
